1	 Control of Vegetation a) Check vegetation along the path verges for excessive growth, nominally above 30 cm. Strim as required. b) Ensure grass does not encroach pathway. Cut back as necessary. c) Clear path of excessive leaves and debris as required. Note: Carry out in dry weather. d) Check for overhanging branches and/or bushes encroaching on the pathway. Trim branches/bushes, as necessary. e) Check for fallen trees obstructing the pathway. If not practical to clear inform the Estate. 2	Drainage Check drains are free from debris. Clear out any silt, debris and vegetation blocking the main channel and inlet/outlet ditches. Note: Drains should not be more than half full during periods of heaviest flow.	Drainage Rods		
3	 Path Features a) Inspect notices at vantage points along the pathway and ensure they are clearly visible. Check for security of attachment, damage, and legibility. Replace, as necessary. b) Ensure directional signs point in the right direction. c) Inspect gates for general condition. Ensure they operate correctly. Pay particular attention to latches and hinges, grease/oil as required. d) Check safety barriers and fences for general condition. Repair/replace as required. e) Check bench for security of attachment and condition, especially paintwork. Repaint, as necessary. f) Check water inflow/outflow of pond. Check pond for debris. 4	 Surface Condition a) Inspect path surface for evidence of general wear and tear. b) Check for evidence of water running onto the path surface and causing surface scouring to take place. c) Check for signs of water running down the path causing erosion. d) Check for soft spots on the pathway that may indicate where water is seeping beneath the surface. e) Ensure geotex membrane is not exposed or damaged. f) Phase in repairs to path as required. 5	Bridge Check general condition of bridge. Pay particular attention to walkway and handrails. Report findings, including any structural concerns, to the Landowners/Council.	No Requirement
